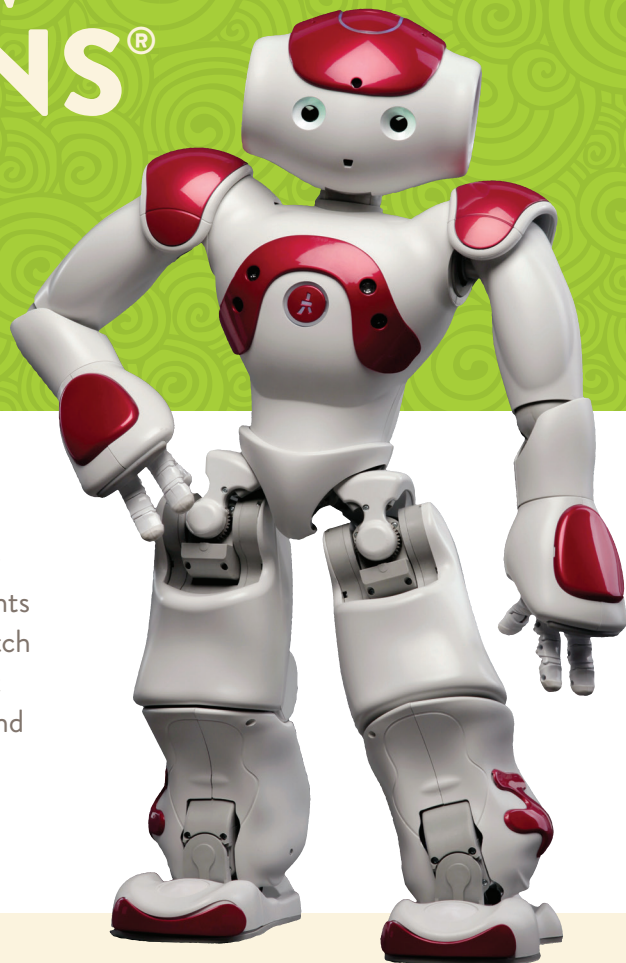

NAO introduces students to the tech world by teaching computer programming. All of NAO's actions are programmed by the students themselves, making him more than just something for them to watch and marvel at—he's a fun learning tool, too! WHAT EXACTLY CAN NAO DO?

Every NAO[®] module enhances critical learning skills and is designed to be programmed around specific interests of the students at Champions. Modules include:

1 "Let's Tell a Story": Students will embrace their inner storytellers as they come up with a story and then program NAO to recite it. They can even program NAO's movements to add to the intrigue (or comedy!) of the story.

2 "Let's Dance": NAO is quite the dancer, and he's not afraid to show it...but he can't do it all on his own. He needs choreographers—and that's where the students come in. By using mathematics and programming skills, students can teach NAO a dance routine and watch their creativity come to life.

3 "Let's Play a Game": Students can program NAO to read facial expressions so that he's able to play games. It'll feel like there's another child in the room—he may not look like everyone else, but he will certainly fit right in!

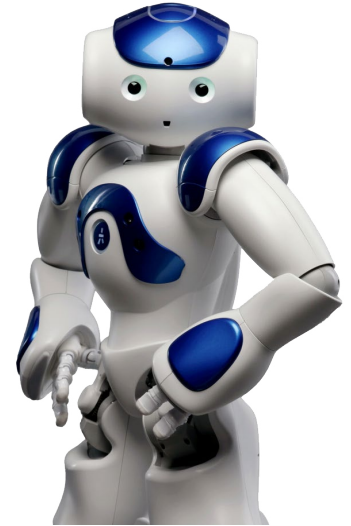
