

Based on ISBE's guidance, face coverings (masks) must be worn at all times in schools by students and staff. The exception is when a student or staff member has a documented medical need that would demonstrate that wearing a face covering would be medically counter indicated. This is not a local decision. D70 is planning on providing cloth face coverings for students in addition to what their parents will provide. Disposable face coverings will also be available.






