ISBE and IDPH require that face coverings (masks) be worn at all times in schools by students and staff. 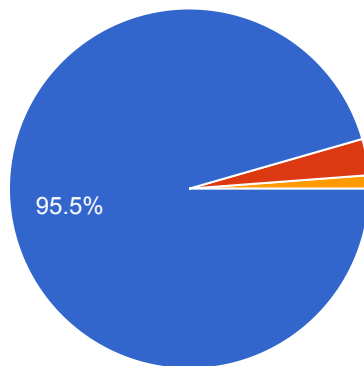
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- My child(ren) will wear a face-covering/mask to meet ISBE and IDPH requirements for in-person learning.

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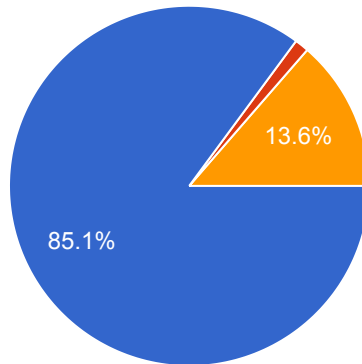

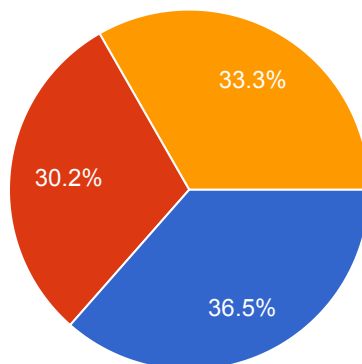

Your answer to this question will enable D70 to work with our transportation vendor (Lakeside) to review and develop bus routes for the fall. Restore Illinois and ISBE guidance for the 2020-2021 school year allows for up to fifty (50) total occupants on a school bus in Phase 4.
