This year, we plan to utilize a web based tool called WeVideo as a video creation tool. This tool works well on Chromebooks and allows students the flexibility to complete projects at school and at home. Students will access WeVideo via their Google Apps for Education account provided by the district. At the completion of the project, the students will share the videos with their classroom teacher and the students will have access to their completed video within their Google Drive.

WeVideo would have a record of the student's name and school email address, but they do not share that information with anyone nor do they use it to contact the students directly. WeVideo is committed to protecting the privacy of students and is fully compliant with the FERPA and COPPA rules and guidelines. In compliance with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) of 1998, the Services are not intended for use by students under the age of 13 years without the consent of a parent or legal guardian.

In an effort to continue to be transparent with the tools being utilized, we are seeking permission for your student to use WeVideo.
