These expectations are for students, parents and staff members.

On the following pages, you will find the expectations for the different locations around Rockland School.

HALLWAY EXPECTATIONS

Statement: The hallway will be quiet and not interrupt classroom instruction.

Student Expectations:

1. Face forward and watch where you are going.
2. Voices Off.
3. Stay on one side of the hallway/stairs.
4. Hands and feet to yourself.

Staff Expectations:

1. Walk with your class while moving in the hallway.
2. Consistently hold students to all expectations.
3. Walk students out at the specials, lunch, and end of the day.

BATHROOM EXPECTATIONS

Statement: The bathroom area will be clean, safe and quiet.

Student Expectations:

1. Use whisper voice inside and outside the bathroom.
2. Wait for your turn.
3. Allow privacy from others.
4. Flush, wash hands, turn off water, pick up trash.

Staff Expectations:

1. Consistently hold students to all expectations.
2. Monitor the area for noise and neatness.
3. Send one student at a time from the classroom.

INDOOR RECESS/COMPUTER LAB EXPECTATIONS

Statement: Indoor recess and computer lab will be a safe and fun area for everyone.

Student Expectations:

1. Use respectful and appropriate language and volume when playing with friends.
2. Learning Center: Use games and materials appropriately. Clean up your space when finished.
3. Video Area: Be a good listener and sit quietly
4. Computer Lab: Treat technology with respect. Be sure computers are logged out.

Staff Expectations:

1. Friendly, but firm supervision.
2. Consistently implement student expectations.

LUNCHROOM EXPECTATIONS

Statement: The lunchroom will be a calm place to eat lunch and talk with classmates.

Student Expectations:

1. Be kind to one another.
2. Keep hands and feet to yourself
3. Use good manners.
 - Say please and thank you
 - Eat food politely
 - Keep conversations to appropriate topics
4. Your food is not to be shared or traded.
5. Clean your space when you are done eating.

Staff Expectations:

1. Friendly, but firm supervision.
 2. Consistently implement student expectations.
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RECESS EXPECTATIONS

Statement: The recess/playground area will be a safe and fun area for everyone.

Student expectations:

1. Use equipment and fields safely and correctly.
2. Keep hands and feet to self.
3. Use respectful language when playing and problem solving.
4. Return equipment to the cart at the end of recess.
5. Line up after the 1st bell rings and wait to be sent into the building.

Staff Expectations:

1. Friendly, but firm supervision.
2. Consistently implement student expectations and game rules.

OFFICE EXPECTATIONS

Statement: The office will be a safe, organized and quiet area.

Student Expectations

1. If the secretary is talking on the phone, wait quietly until she hangs up.
2. If you are there to see the principal, check with the secretary first.
3. If you are missing recess, bring something you can do quietly. Put away any office toys before you leave the office.
- 4. If you need to get through the security door, come back to the office and ask to be let through.**
